

What materials are recyclable?

Drop in the appropriate blue bin:

PAPER



accepted: paper of all kinds, newspaper, office paper and magazines

not accepted: paper contaminated by food or liquids, wax paper and mixed paper (sauce mix envelopes, etc.)

METAL



accepted: cans, tins and aluminum foil

not accepted: paint and spray cans
For larger items such as ovens, lawn mowers and barbeques, drop off in designated area at municipal dump.

CARDBOARD



accepted: all types

not accepted: contaminated cardboard such as pizza boxes, ice cream containers, milk or juice cartons

PLASTIC



accepted: all types of plastic containers from number 1 to 7

not accepted: plastic bags

Remember to remove the label on plastic and metal containers, and rinse clean.

There is also...

For wine, liquor, beer bottles and cans, telephone books and catalogues go to the Missinaibi Hardware.

At home, all organic matter, except meat, can be composted.

Where are the recycling bins situated?

Near the Municipal office
500, Hwy 11
Mattice

Please note that in order to facilitate the insertion of plastic and tin cans into the recycling bins, the access doors have been unlocked so that larger items or bulk containers can be emptied in a single operation. Nonetheless, we remind you to exert caution as these metal doors (same type as the bear-proof garbage containers in town) are fairly heavy and cannot be blocked in the open position.
