## Pets (dogs and cats)

- You must purchase a dog and cat license every year at the municipal office
- The owners and dog or cat guardians must pick up after their pets
- Dogs and cats must remain within the limits of your property or be on a leash under the control of a responsible adult
- If caught, a stray dog and cat will be seized and impounded

## Missinaïbi Clinic

It is located at 500 Hwy 11 east of Mattice, at the back of the municipal complex.

Opening Hours :

- Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday - 8:30 am to noon and 12:30 pm to 4:30 pm
- Thursday - 7:30 am to noon and 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm

Services offered include: blood tests, consultation with a Physician, Nurse Practitioner, Diabetes Center, Dental Hygienist, Dietitian, Professional Mental Health, and others.

### Rink

During the winter, an ice rink allows minor hockey teams and adults to play Canada's game. Public skating sessions are held twice a week. Free "Sponge Hockey Puck" sessions are held several times a week. During the summer, the ice surface is transformed into badminton courts. The ice rink surface is available for family or group activities at an affordable price. The sports complex also includes four locker rooms with showers and there is a snack bar at the entrance.

### Community Hall

On the second floor of the sports complex, a fully accessible community hall is available for meetings, cultural events, weddings, community meals, etc. A well equipped kitchen, bar and stage are also available. The hall has a seating capacity of 240 to 360 people but can accommodate more than 400 people for concerts and similar events.

### Teen Center

A meeting place for teens is set up on the second floor and allows them to hold supervised activities on Friday and Saturday evenings.

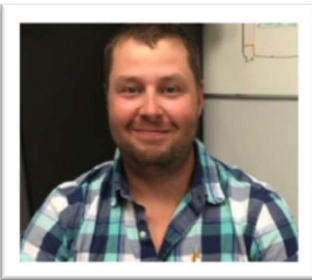


## Municipal Council

## Construction and Renovation

A building permit must be requested at least five business days before the work begins. You must be able to provide a description of the work and a plan or sketch of expected renovations. We strongly recommend that you communicate with the municipal office well in advance to inquire beforehand and avoid unpleasant surprises.



## Waste Collection

Weekly residential and commercial waste collection services are offered by the Municipality of Mattice - Val Côté. Garbage must be brought near the street, at the end of your driveway, in one or more rigid and covered garbage containers, on the morning of the waste collection.

Waste collection schedule:

Tuesday from 9 am to 1 pm: The village of Mattice, local businesses, and rural residences located east of Shallow Lake Road

Friday from 9 am to 1 pm: Local businesses, Shallow Lake area, residences located west of Shallow Lake Road and the village of Val Côté

## Recycling

### Where is the recycling bin?

The red recycling bin is located near the Municipal office, 500 Hwy 11.

### What materials are recyclable?

#### PAPER AND CARDBOARD

**Accepted:** newspaper, paper of all kinds, magazines, folded cardboard, well rinsed polycarb and aseptic containers

**Refused:** paper and cardboard contaminated by food or liquids, Tim & McDo cups, dog food bags, potato bags, used cardboard plates, ice cream containers, pizza boxes

#### METAL

**Accepted:** clean cans, aluminium containers, clean foil plates

**Refused:** paint container and spray cans

**Note:** larger items, such as ovens, lawn mowers and barbeques, can be dropped off in designated area at municipal landfill site

#### PLASTIC

**Accepted:** all types of plastic containers numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7 (except no. 6)

**Refused:** plastic bags, plastic wrapping

#### REFUSED:

All types of glass, styrofoam and wood
