REQUEST FOR TENDER

GAGNON ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT

A pressure treated wood culvert is currently located on Gagnon Road, at approximately 0.9 km from Highway 11. The Municipality wishes to replace the same with a large corrugated steel pipe (CSP) culvert.

Refer to the attached engineering plans (Appendix A) for a clear understanding of the requirements and of the work involved.

Notes:

- 1) a walking bridge must be set up by the contractor in order to allow residents that live north of the culvert to cross from one side to the other.
- 2) there is a buried telephone cable that crosses the work area. Before the project starts, that cable will be unplugged, dug out, rolled and set aside by Northern Tel. Before the work is completed, Northern Tel will reinstall the cable on top of the culvert.
- 3) the contractor will notify the Municipality of its actual start date 2 weeks prior.

Services requested include but are not limited to the following:

Item No.	Work to be accomplished
1.1	Obtained required work permits (MNRFP or other) and abide by their requirements.
1.2	Remove existing culvert and dispose of the same at the municipal landfill (no tipping fees).
1.3	Prepare the terrain for the installation of the new culvert/erosion control.
1.4	Supply and install a 2.44 meters in diameter and 27.4 meters long aluminised CSP culvert.
1.5	Restore and smooth out the culvert approaches, using Granular A backfill from an MTO certified quarry to reinstate the roadway. Supply and place rip rap on slopes on each side.
1.6	Clean up the work area

- Received on other than the Tender form (pages 1 to 3)
- Incomplete

3. Award of Contract

The award of this Contract is subject to the approval of the Mattice – Val Côté Municipal Council.

4. Insurance – liability, WSIB, etc.

- 4.1 The Successful Tenderer shall take out and keep in force a comprehensive policy of public liability and property damage insurance of at least **\$2,000,000**. Such policy shall name the Municipality as an additional insured.
- 4.2 The Successful Tenderer shall provide a Certificate from the Workplace Safety Insurance Board (WSIB) stating that he/she is in good standing with the WSIB.
- 4.3 The Successful Tenderer shall ensure that the equipment used to perform the work activities is safe and in good working order.

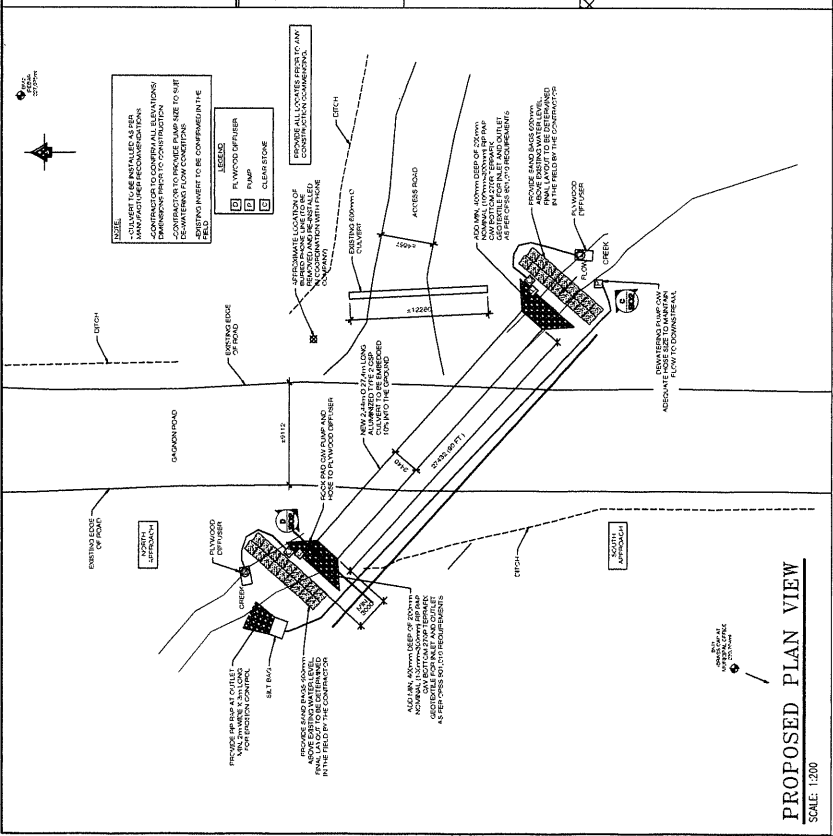
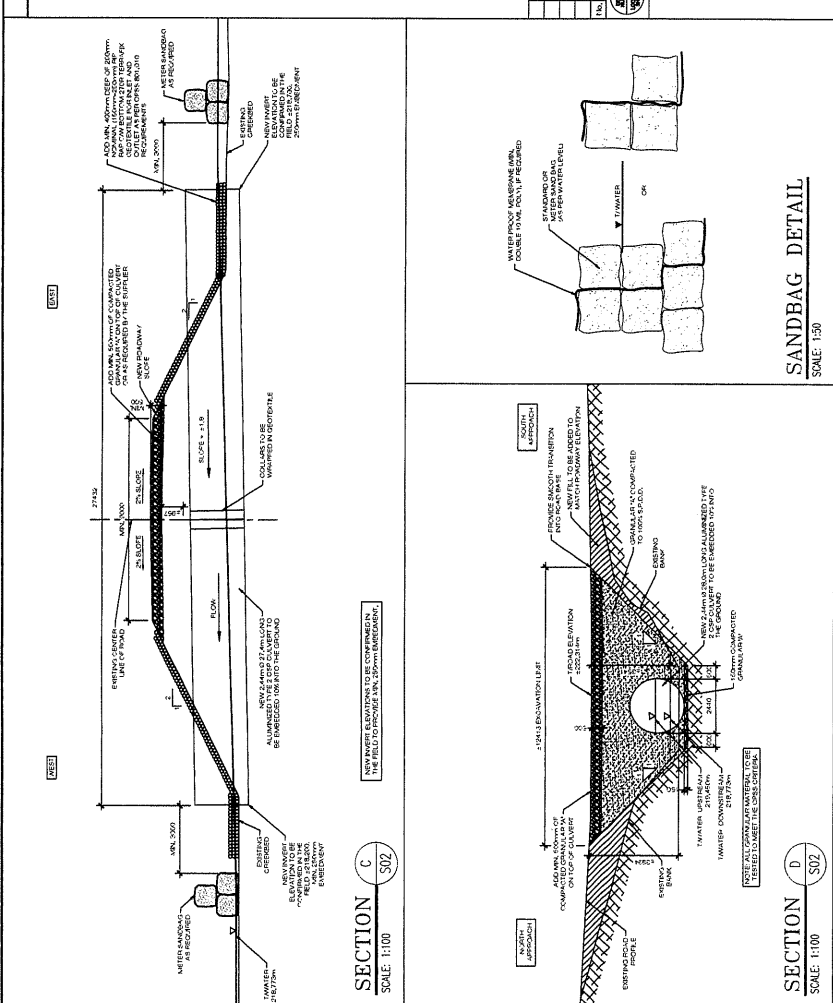
